Program Fees: There is a **\$750 per student Program Fee** that covers most expenses a student will incur during the school year: textbooks, materials, lab fees, field trips, equipment usage, activities, competitions, yearbooks, technology & software licenses, standardized testing, personal and academic counseling.

Not included in program fees: transportation, afterschool, lunches and meals, uniforms, AP class & exam fees, musical instruments, overnight trips, participation in interscholastic sports and competitions.

International Students: California Crosspoint High School is authorized by the United States government to issue the I-20 form necessary for obtaining the F-1 international student visa. Please see our separate literature for specific information and costs for enrolling in our international program or for staying in our student residences.

Financial Policies

eTuition: School families are strongly encouraged to enroll in the school's free eTuition service. Families will receive their monthly bill several days before the due date and if there are no questions, the amount will be transferred electronically from your checking account. If you have questions or concerns, you have a few days to contact the school office to get the matter cleared.

Refunds: School fees (e.g. testing, registration, etc.) are non-refundable. Refunds on items not received or used are subject to the policies of the publisher, manufacturer, or supplier.

Cancellations: Cancellation of annual services (e.g. tuition, transportation, tutoring, etc.) are subject to a 10% charge based on the annual amount. After the first semester, tuition will not be pro-rated or refunded for the remainder of the year even if the student withdraws.

Schedule: First installments or annual payments are due June 15, 2024, then on the 1st of every month from September 1, 2024, through May 1, 2025. Monthly statements are issued before each billing period.

Unpaid Balances: Payments are considered **overdue** after the 5th of each month at which time a minimum **late fee** of \$30/month or 1.5% of the outstanding balance will be charged. Families will be charged \$30 for each occurrence of a **returned check** plus any bank charges incurred by the school. Families with **severely delinquent** accounts will not be allowed to re-enroll and may be refused attendance until the balance is settled. Please contact the school office before letting your account balance become a problem.
